Tapping into the Life and Immortality of Jesus: Overcome Death, Disease, & Trauma

- I. Break the Pattern: Get Healed of Trauma and Bitterness and Defeat Death (Colossians 1:28–29, AMPC)
 - A. In the natural, trauma causes aging, sickness, and death. We need to learn to possess our soul in peace.
 - B. **Trauma leads to death**. (Job 1:2–3; Job 1:14–15 (AMPC); Job 1:16–19, AMPC; Job 1:13, AMPC.)
 - C. Trauma brings on sickness. (Job 2:7–13, AMPC; Job 3:13; 3:20–22, AMPC)
 - D. Activation.
- II. Power over Death (1 Corinthians 15:41; Galatians 6:8, TPT; 2 Timothy 1:10, TPT; Colossians 1:28, AMPC; Colossians 1:29, AMPC)
 - A. My encounter with death. (1 Corinthians 15:26, NKJV)
 - B. It's not aging—it's the spirit of death.
 - C. **Jesus stripped the power of death.** (Hebrews 2:14, AMPC; II Timothy 1:10, NKJV)
 - D. Breaking the Law gives death legal right to attack your bodily organs.
 - E. No one can keep the whole law. Law-breaking leads to death. (Romans 6:23)
 - F. Christ overcame death by taking on the curse of the law on the cross.
 - G. Activation.

III. Defeating Death in the Courts of Heaven

- A. Satan loves the law because he knows that no one can keep it perfectly. (James 2)
- B. Jesus has shed His blood on your behalf so that you can receive a verdict of not guilty, every single time. (Revelation 12:11, AMPC)
- C. Promises of youth in the Bible are connected to the courts of heaven. (Psalm 103)
- D. Activation.

IV. The Power of the Grace Court (Hebrews 4:16, NKJV)

- A. Here, all decisions and rulings are based on the grace and mercy of God.
- B. The Bible says mercy always triumphs over judgment. (James 2:13 NKJV)
- C. Within your salvation is healing for your body, deliverance and protection from the enemy, and the ability for you to be preserved from death's decay and be made whole and healthy. (Romans 5:20, AMPC)
- D. Grace breaks off the spirit of death and Brings life. (Romans 5:12,15,17, AMPC)
- E. Activation in the Grace Court.

V. We Are Called to Be Judges (1 Corinthians 6:3, AMPC)

- A. We are not to be judgmental to others but rather release righteous judgements on their behalf. (Matthew 7:1–3, KJV; 1 Corinthians 11:31, AMPC)
- B. We are called to bring justice to the powerless. We do this by taking our seats as judges.
- C. Activation.
